Tech Session Recap

Saturday dawned with horizontal snow blowing across the slick Interstate as I drove to the shop to plow the snow in case anyone showed up.

I barely had the coffee going when Dave Herreid arrived carrying all kinds of pastries, followed closely by Hudson and Stillwater area members Tom Moerke, Rod Richert, and Tim Hood. Also attending — Spencer Angel, Greg Lauser, Jeff Lumbard, Dick Matthews, Gary Wetzel, Fred Ambli, Greg and Suzanne Willodson, Steve Greenway, and probably some I can't recall.

Dave Herreid's Tri-carb roadster was the prime exhibit. We talked through the restoration and the modifications performed.

The wiring harness was specially ordered with additional wiring for an alternator, a second fuel pump, Long Range and Fog lamps (front and rear), reverse lamp, and power receptacles for electronics. Additions also include interior footwell lighting, 14 inch electric radiator pusher fan, and low oil pressure engine shut-down switch (just in case), fresh air blower, MSD ignition box, and air horn. Many of the additional electrical items have controls and indicator lamps on a fabricated dash sub-panel.

Suspension and drive train modifications beyond the overhauled and upgraded engine include 5 speed transmission, 3.54 rear gears, MGB front shocks (for negative camber on front suspension) with heavy duty valves, and 7/8 inch sway bar bolt on wheel and hub modification (6 sets available) with 8 spoke Mini-Lite wheels. BJ8 front brake calipers, stainless steel brake & fuel lines and braided hoses are also installed.

Engine accessories include 6 blade tropical fan, Wizard aluminum radiator with polished coolant recovery tank, oil cooler with thermostat control, collapsible steering column, and spin-on oil filter.

A removable trailer hitch for hauling a bike rack or pulling a small trailer is also being installed.

We also talked a little about the 100-6 which is once again sporting long range driving and fog lamps. These are now being actuated by a wiring harness of my design (4 more available) which include rear fog and reverse lamps as in Dave's Tri-carb. We never got to look at the Morris Minor.

The session was scheduled till 1 but lasted until 3 PM
