The President's Report

No, the pillars of power can prove to be much more complicated, Al. Such is also true to the MAHC. As the president of your club, I've discovered through a careful reading of its bylaws that true power rests with the board of directors. This came to light when I contacted officers to thank them for their service in 2008 and ask them if they would be willing to continue into 2009. In the case of the board members, the bylaws require a 2/5 or 3/5 turn over each year requiring at least one more candidate than the number of positions filled. Tom Hazen has proposed that we eliminate the extra candidate (fall guy?) and let the board choose persons to join the board to be voted upon at the annual November meeting.

The bylaws also state that the "President of the MAHC appoint a search committee...to find candidates for election to the Board of Directors." In my opinion, the last thing anyone needs is an unnecessary committee and instead propose amending the bylaws to mandate a September board meeting to initiate board succession.

Speaking of succession, the only other office turning over each year is that of vice-president. Nowhere in the bylaws is that process codified. Traditionally the vice-president has picked his/her successor. If the club agrees that to tackle the amending process, it might be in the club's interest to put this in writing.

As president, I'll ask for thoughts on this topic PIE at in January and February to see if this is worth pursuing.

Finally, I would be remiss if I didn't extend a belated thank you to Steve and Kim Rixen for the donation of silent auction items in the memory of Sandy Rixen. Seventy-five dollars was raised for the club treasury at the annual banquet. Thanks also to those contributing.
