

# The Presidential Corner

Lately I've been thinking about how far we should go to restore and update our Healey. When my mother placed the car in our care a few years ago, it was given to us without conditions. She was always passionate, however, about keeping the car as original as possible.

For about the first four months driving the car, we aimed to honor those wishes. When it became clear, however, that the car would be ruined if I continued to drive it with its original side shift transmission, a project to convert to a five-speed was the given the green light. Greg did the conversion with the goal of making it 100% reversible. He even bought a flywheel on eBay and a fiberglass tunnel from AH Spares, so the original pieces would not meet up with a drill bit or a hack saw.

When my mother would come by for a visit, Greg would take her out to the garage to see how the "repairs" were going - the resurfaced flywheel, the new 9 ½ " clutch, the rear seal kit. No need to mention that the shiny transmission she was looking at was actually from a Lexus SC300, or that the aluminium bell housing was ordered from a guy in North Carolina.

We finally came clean after we had completed the project, because surely she would notice that the carpet had a hole from which a crazy bendy long shifter no longer sprouted. She thought it was just great! Driving the car confirmed that it was indeed the best idea we've (he's) had in ages.

We go back and forth between renewing the original features of the car and upgrading the car to make it easier to drive. Greg has plans in the works to reconfigure the batteries back to the original pair of 6-volts. Other upgrades we've discussed include replacing the rear end gears (to lower rpm when cruising), sealing up exhaust leaks (we're killing off brain cells when the top is up), and a valve job (we gave up smoking; the car should too).

It seems what's most honest about taking care of our car is what works for us – what will allow us to drive the car more frequently and with greater enjoyment. There are years of projects ahead, but my initial belief that the car must be strictly preserved in its original state is fading away. What really inspires us to make improvements to our Healey is seeing what other members have done to their cars to make them mechanical and aesthetic masterpieces. Stay tuned...!




