Presidentail Ponderings

What's an MG girl doing leading an Austin Healey club?

My history with little British cars goes back to the early 1980s. My cousin bought a ratty Triumph TR-6. It had bad paint, a missing top, and an unpredictable temperament. But it was a red convertible, and that was pretty cool.

Mechanical aptitude didn't run strong on that side of the family, and parts were nearly impossible to come by at the time. Frustrated, my cousin sold the car and moved to California.

But by then, I had been bitten by the love of top-down driving. I went on to be part owner of a cherry-red concours-winning TR-6 and a TR-3 named Holly, because of its red, green, and white color scheme. When they went away, I decided an old Mazda Miata – something reliable, with available parts, and with a top that didn't have the mechanics of an erector set--was a better fit for me.

When I met my husband Steve, I was happily driving Rosebud, my '92 Miata. Steve, however, was a British car guy and a member of the Minnesota Austin Healey Club going back to the early '90s - when he inherited his dad's 100-6. He worked on British cars and loved driving them.

When he revived his LBC repair business, he asked: How do you think it looks for the spouse of a British car mechanic to be driving a Miata? He had a point.

So when a red 1975 MG Midget with a blown engine and an owner at the end of his rope showed up in his shop wanting to unload it, Steve decided it would be mine.

We spent the winter rebuilding the engine. For me, who could check oil, change a fuse, and replace an air filter, it was an extreme stretch goal. Could I do this? How long would it take Steve to give up on me? If I did manage to do it, would it run or would this have been a huge waste of time?

With a lot of guidance and help, I turned every bolt, became friends with the pneumatic wrench, and built an engine that has been running strong for eight years. I was once again a British car owner.

But being involved with little British cars is about much more than engines and transmissions. It's about camaraderie, shared experience, and stories. We've all broken down, been caught in the rain with top down, and run out of gas, even though the indicator still says we have a quarter tank. And we've come to each other's rescue with tools, parts, and tow strap.

It's about more than being Austin Healey people or MG people or Triumph people; it's being part of a broad community -- something that never occurred to me when I took that first ride in my cousin's TR-6.

BLACK HILLS TRAVEL TIPS

REGISTER FOR CONCLAVE NOW Then book your stay. The Mountain Grand is sold out, so call the Holiday Inn Express & Suites (605/578-3330) or the Hotel by Gold Dust (605/559-1400). You may check-in as early as Sept. 4 at Conclave room rates. All Minnesota club members will help host the event and are encouraged to be there no later than Sept. 5. Checkout will be on Sept. 11.

OBEY SPEED LIMITS Resist temptations to test your LBC's speed capabilities on Black Hills byways. Local authorities enforce speed limits scrupulously. Observing speed limits will safeguard you and your vehicle from sudden wildlife encounters of the bad kind while keeping any passenger more relaxed and happier.

NATIONAL PARKS PASS If you do not have a National Parks Senior Lifetime Pass, consider buying one before coming to the Black Hills. It will pay for itself on this trip. Anyone 62 or older may purchase a pass. One pass gets everyone in a car into most national parks and monuments free. For details go to: <https://www.nps.gov/planyourvisit/senior-pass-changes.htm>.

COMING FROM THE EAST Take rest stops off I-90 at both the **PIONEER AUTO MUSEUM** in Murdo, S.D., and **BADLANDS NATIONAL PARK** near Wall, S.D. A National Parks pass is your ticket for free admittance to the Badlands. The **PIONEER AUTO MUSEUM**, **WALL DRUG** and other attractions will require coin of the realm.

COMING FROM THE WEST Take time to see **DEVILS TOWER** just 24 miles north off the I-90 exit for Sundance, Wyoming. A National Parks pass is your ticket for admittance. Stretch your legs on a 1.25-mile paved path that circles the base of the tower amid tall pines and big boulders. Be sure to look for climbers scaling the monolith. Or, stop at the **SANFORD LAB HOMESTAKE VISITOR CENTER** on Main Street in Lead, S.D., to learn how the former deepest underground gold mine is leading scientific study of dark matter and neutrinos. Tours of Lead and the lab are available.




COMING FROM THE SOUTH Don't miss visiting **JEWEL CAVE NATIONAL MONUMENT** and **WIND CAVE NATIONAL PARK** using your National Parks pass. **CRAZY HORSE MEMORIAL**, **CUSTER STATE PARK** and **MAMMOTH SITE AT HOT SPRINGS**, S.D., charge entry fees. The Custer State Park fee is a seven-day pass, which will come in handy for repeatedly enjoying its winding roads, abundant wildlife and a variety of stunning scenery.
