TECH SESSION - Paint Repair & Maintenance

On Saturday morning about 10:00, a good bunch of Healeyites gathered at Gary & Eileen Wetzel's home for an interesting Tech Session. Eduardo Briceno is an Automotive Paint Restorer & Consultant. He and his wife Shelley were there to introduce us to his techniques of enhancing and preserving the finishes on our collector cars.

Eduardo selected Carol Johnk's Red TR-6 to demonstrate (Carol let Jeff drive it that day!). First he cleaned an area with water to remove any dust. Then he proceeded to apply several products in a straight line motion to bring out the paint color. Circular motion when polishing is not recommended. The uses of fine sandpaper and power buffers were also discussed. He maintained that they could be used in some cases, but should only be used by experienced people. The final polishing was done with rolled cotton. The result was very beautiful!

After the demonstration, Eileen had us proceed through her lovely kitchen where the food was displayed. A great lunch of Sloppy Joes, salads, and brownies hit the spot. We ate outside on the deck, enjoying the warm Spring day. A big thanks to Gary & Eileen for hosting!!

A Fix for Wearing Carpet



I had a heel mark wearing deeply into my Healey carpet. I suppose I should have bought a vinyl mat to use over the top of the carpet, but the carpet feels nice without it so I never did. So I had to decide whether to replace the carpet piece, or cover it somehow, or live with growing ugliness.

An answer came from scrutinizing Paul Nesse's current car, his Aston Green 427 Cobra. Paul had an upholsterer stitch a bit of vinyl stair covering such as sold in any hardware store, over the heel area of his carpet. Shamelessly I decided to copy his method, and asked him for the address of the upholsterer. It was Beach Upholstery, 303 5th Street North, Hudson, WI 54106-1008, phone 715 220 3694. A quick trip to Wisconsin, and a few days later I had my fix, as you can see in the photos. Nice, friendly craftsmen who are happy to work with car guys and gals on custom projects or whatever you have. So, when you see us on the road, you can take a look. Barbara observed that it won't make the accelerator stick, either. They haven't had a single recall yet. Neither did DMH!


